Post-Sale Inspection

Benefits of Post-Sale Inspection

Buyers will save time since inspections take place before purchased vehicles ever leave the auction. They get the peace of mind that their vehicles were represented properly by the seller, and they will save money by minimizing major unexpected repairs, and being properly compensated for issues that weren't properly disclosed by the seller.

Eligibility and Time Frame

Any vehicle sold under Ride/Drive or Limited Guarantee is eligible for post-sale inspection. Vehicles can be guaranteed for 7 days or 14 days. Inspections can be ordered on the block or any time before close of business on the day of sale. Dealers may also sign up for inspections to be done automatically on all of their vehicles.

The following items are included in the post-sale inspection:

Engine, including leaks/noises

Transmission - engagement, shift quality

4x4 engagement, abnormal noises

Speedometer/Odometer – verification of miles and function

Frame/unibody inspection

Flood inspection

Airbag system function (Ride/Drive only)

Anti-Lock Brake system function (Ride/Drive only)

Emissions equipment present/functional (Ride/Drive only)

Air conditioning operation (Ride/Drive only)

Electrical accessories (Ride/Drive only, vehicles up to 4 model years old)

Frame Inspection

Don't have the time or expertise to do your own frame checks? Frame inspection protects the buyer against undisclosed structural damage. Frame inspection may be requested at any time within 7 days of day of purchase. Sale day is Day 1.

Hail Inspection

Colorado Law requires hail damage to be disclosed by the seller. Auction rules allow for arbitration for hail on the day of sale only. Inspect all purchased vehicles before leaving the auction, or protect yourself by requesting a Hail Inspection.
